Kim has been a mainstay in the Irish International team since her debut and was awarded the Irish International Woman's Cricket of the Year in 2015. Kim was a member of the successful Sydney Sixers WBBL2 &3 campaigns including taking wickets in both finals. She was a member of the Irish team for the 2018 Woman's World T20 finishing the tournament as her teams standout player. Ahead of the 2019/20 Summer in Australia, Kim announced that she was leaving Irish cricket to take up a 2 year contract with Victoria in Australia.
